The Mental Health Counselor's responsibilities can be varied, but generally include the following:

- Provide various outpatient mental health services with the goal of patient recovery to children and their families
- Conduct intakes and provide individual, group, and family therapies
- Develop service plans and conduct reviews as required throughout the duration of treatment
- Provide mental health assessments, counseling, referrals, and intervention services
- Complete and maintain documentation according to federal and state guidelines.
- Part of a team on an interdisciplinary service delivery model
- Patriciate actively in weekly Supervision, Case Conference and trainings
- Attend trainings as required to maintain licensure and certifications, as well as, gaining personal awareness
- Strong affinity for working with children, adolescents, and families

Educational requirements; Masters; Counseling, Social Work, Marriage and Family Therapy or related degree. Agency can provide supervision requirements for licensure.

Experience preferred but not required providing treatment to children, adolescents and families

Hours; Monday- Friday; typically, 9-5 unless clients' needs dictate otherwise. **One or two evenings a week required to meet clients scheduling needs.**,
