Counselor II

Job duties;

- Provide psychosocial and psychiatric rehabilitation services that help clients with mental health, substance use or emotional disorders adjust to their social environment
- Provide individual or group counseling during scheduled program hours
- Assess a patient's current condition and level of social functionality, developing a treatment plan that helps a client learn skill sets needed for independent living
- Monitor patients' progress, help them achieve their social integration goals, and intervene in crisis situations
- Provision of Tox Screens
- Provide case management services dependent on assessment of client needs
- Other duties as assigned by Supervisor

Educational requirements; Bachelors Social Work or related undergraduate degree; Masters; counseling, social work or related degree. Agency can provide supervision requirements for licensure.

Comfort level with SPMI population required.

Hours; Monday-Friday; typically, 9-5 unless clients' needs dictate otherwise

Twelve paid holidays; accrued vacation and sick time available after probationary period in first year.
