

Mental Health Counselor for PROS Program

Under the supervision of the Program Director, the Counselor conducts client assessments, determines a diagnosis following criteria, develops treatment plans, and provides direct treatment.

The Counselor IV, part of a team on an interdisciplinary service delivery model, has the following duties & responsibilities:

- provide various PROS Program mental health services with the goal of patient recovery
- conduct intakes and individual, group, and family therapies
- develop Individualized Recovery Plans and conduct reviews as needed throughout the duration of treatment
- provide mental health assessments, counseling, referrals, and intervention services
- complete and maintain documentation according to federal and state guidelines
- participate actively in Supervision and Case Conference
- Attend trainings as required to maintain licensure and certifications, as well as, gaining personal awareness

Educational Requirements:

- a Master's degree in Mental Health or Social Work that leads to licensure.

(Agency can provide supervision requirements for licensure.)

Hours:

Monday – Friday, 9 AM – 5 PM unless client needs dictate otherwise.

(One evening a week may be required to meet clients scheduling needs)
